

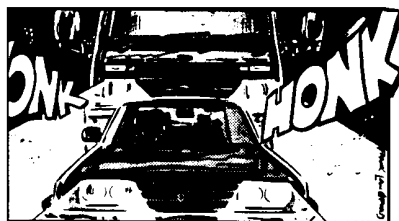

Council plans may turn Beaumont Estate into a rat-run!



The narrow roads on the **Beaumont Estate** will become a traffic rat-run if the plans by the Council to block off the **Capworth Street** and **Vicarage Road**

junction. Traffic travelling from the **High Road** will be unable to get to **Church Road** except by using **Beaumont Estate**.

Lib Dem Focus member Bob Sullivan highlighted this problem to the Council's traffic chief at a recent meeting on the council's Mini Holland plans for Leyton. Bob was concerned that the radical plans for blocking off **Vicarage Road** will have a dramatic effect on the lives of Beaumont residents. He asked that the Council come back with alternatives to stop any rat-running on the estate.

Disappointing exam results for borough schools

The league tables for last summer's GCSE exams were published in January and showed that over half of our secondary schools in Waltham Forest were below the national average of 57.1 per cent whereas all the secondary schools in Redbridge were all above the national average.

Council Tax Going Up

Having frozen Council Tax before the local and General Elections they are now going to increase it. As from 1st April your Council Tax will go up 1.86 per cent.

The Council's charge to Band D payers is an extra £26.97 a year.

Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) fees going up

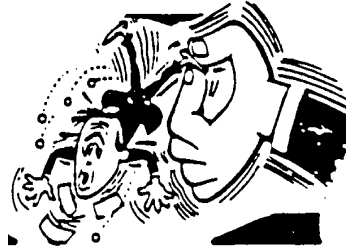
Having reduced CPZ fees to £25 before the elections they are now putting them up 40 per cent to £35.

Council Tax benefit receivers take a hit

Having kept low charges to council tax benefit receivers before elections, those who are the most vulnerable in our society will have to pay a swingeing 24 percent of their Council Tax bill.

Councillor allowances

Having cut councillors' allowances by 5 percent before the elections they are now granting themselves a whacking increase. Council taxpayers will be forking out over £1 million to give to councillors. Labour councillors will pay a percentage of this straight to the local Labour Party.

The Focus Team is chasing L&Q Housing Association to stop people getting into Lea Hall Gardens to dump their rubbish.

Lib Dems - Keeping YOU informed

Ruckholt Road - noisy road hump

Residents are complaining about the newly laid road hump in Ruckholt Road by the Bike Shack which is causing scraping and bumping noise as vehicles cross the hump.

Focus has contacted the Council to reduce the level and height of the hump so that vehicles don't crash against the tarmac when going over it.

Primrose Road - uncollected rubbish bins

Residents have had to put up with their rubbish bins uncollected for over two weeks. Focus sorted it out but there is a major problem due to heavy parking in the narrow road which makes it difficult for the large rubbish lorry to get down Primrose Road. The cleansing department is looking into this problem.

Council U Turn on parking

The Council is now planning to make only 5 minute free parking and give drivers a 10 minute leeway before fining them for overstaying the time. Focus says: Why spend time and money changing the signs, just leave them as they are and give the extra 10 minute leeway giving drivers 25 minutes free parking.
